Combining that experience with his outrageous humor, Peter Rosenberger is equipping others to bring their “A” game to the brutal challenges of caregiving. Recognizing that most caregivers start their journey abruptly, with little or no training — or warning — Peter offers “just in time” tips learned over a lifetime of caregiving.
